Meeting Summary

12:30 p.m.	Welcome Chair Pam Peck welcomed everyone and did a roll call. DEQ staff provided an overview of the Zoom platform and interpretation.
	DEQ Update Cheryl Grabham, DEQ Product Stewardship Manager, provided a high-level overview of Recycling Modernization Act implementation. Highlights included new staff members Stephanie Caldera and Arianne Sperry. Arianne will focus on the coordination of all parts of the RMA. Stephanie will take over Alex's role in coordinating the Recycling Council and other projects.
	The Commingled Recycling Processing Facility technical workgroup will start meeting this month. This group will meet 6-8 times and will advise DEQ about permitting and certification for material recovery facilities and the implementation of the studies required to set the fees the PROs will pay to the commingled processing facilities. Learn more at their <u>web page.</u>
	Local governments who want to be eligible for funding to expand their recycling systems will complete a needs assessment survey by April 2023.
	DEQ will conduct a statewide waste composition study next year, including inbound and outbound recycling streams from material recovery facilities or MRFs.
	Lastly, Cheryl thanked Senator Kennemer for his time on the Council. The Senate President will appoint a new Senator to the Council.

	Community agreements/Meeting ground rules Chair Peck shared meeting ground rules/community agreements with the Council to ensure meetings go smoothly and everyone is on the same page. Angie Marzano suggested adding language around having Council members identify themselves before speaking. Dylan de Thomas made a motion to accept the agreements, and Liz Start seconded. The vote passed unanimously.

	 Material lists information and discussion DEQ staff provided an overview of the material list process and next steps for both the Recycling Council and the Rulemaking Advisory Committee. Staff reviewed several questions DEQ received from Council members after the last meeting. Staff introduced the trade-offs between shorter vs. longer material lists.Council members discussed the benefits and drawbacks of shorter and longer lists. Staff gave short presentations on five individual materials, each followed by Council discussion. These included PET thermoforms, block white expanded polystyrene, nursery pots and trays, large-format plastic packaging and glass packaging. Council members can send additional input to Alex.Bertolucci@deq.Oregon.gov Later in December, DEQ will post to the web page of the Rulemaking Advisory Committee additional documentation regarding individual materials. DEQ encourages Council members with interest in acceptance lists to review those materials. DEQ will reach back to Council members in January and invite them to identify any materials recommended for acceptance that they wish to discuss at the February Council meeting. This feedback (due Jan. 17) will inform the agenda for that meeting.
