



# Oregon Responsible End Market Acknowledgment Form – Form B

Pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule 340-096-0310(1), all processed materials marketed by a CRPF must be sent to a “Self-Attested Responsible End Market” as defined in 340-090-0670(1) and (2). If you, due to circumstances beyond your control, affirm that no end market that meets Oregon’s “Responsible” standard is available for a specific material, you must request an Acknowledgement Form from Oregon DEQ. This form temporarily allows the requesting entity to market processed materials to a Non-Self Attested Responsible End Market.

**Instructions:** This form is intended to be used by Brokers or Secondary Processors of Oregon-originating recyclable material. Complete one Acknowledgement Form for each end market you are intending to market materials to within 72-hours of sending an email notification to the DEQ. This form **does not** grant relief from reporting requirements listed in OAR 340-096-0300(8)(e) for reporting the final disposition of Oregon-originated recyclable material.

DEQ will respond to a completed Acknowledgement Form within 72-hours of receipt. The approved Acknowledgement Form only applies to the material[s], end market, and up to the timeframe specified in the completed form.

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### Section E) Confidential Business Information

All information submitted to DEQ may be subject to inspection pursuant to the Public Records Law. The following information is conditionally exempt from disclosure under the “trade secrets” exemption, information that:

- (a) is not patented;
- (b) is known only to a limited number of individuals within a commercial concern who have made efforts to maintain the secrecy of the information;
- (c) derives actual or potential economic value from not being disclosed to other persons;
- (d) give its users the chance to obtain a business advantage over competitors not having the information; and
- (e) is not emissions data.

If you believe information that is being provided is a “trade secret,” please mark it as such and DEQ will protect it to the extent allowed under public record law. DEQ may require you to submit information substantiating any claim that information you provided is a trade secret. If DEQ receives a records request and has not received information substantiating the request for information to be confidential, DEQ, may be required to release that information.

### Section F) Oregon DEQ Acknowledgement Determination (DEQ Only)

DEQ has reviewed the completed Acknowledgement Form and acknowledges that the materials listed in Section A will be sent to the end markets listed in Section B for up to six (6) months. When a market that meets Oregon’s “Responsible” standards is established, DEQ will contact the applicant to inform them of the availability of new markets.
