



# How to Find LUST Records

The DEQ Leaking Underground Storage Tank program is now using an online system called Your DEQ Online to hold our publicly available data. This fact sheet will help you find LUST information for sites of interest.

## Data History

The DEQ is working on a major project to digitize its data. As part of this, the LUST program moved all data from its old site database into a new, unified system called Your DEQ Online. The goal is to bring all DEQ programs into this one system, combining older, previously separate databases. This effort will make the data easier to access for the public and anyone who needs it. The LUST Program has been active since before digital records were common and has a significant volume of paper files that may not be digitized. ## Searching the System



The LUST program records are housed in the project module. Modules can be found the far-left side of your screen. Once you are in the correct module you are ready to begin your search.

Utilizing the search panel on the left side of the screen to search for site by project name, project number, project address, environmental interest, and project type. For best results, start with limited information such as house number and street name (e.g. 1111 or Main St). If you have too many results in response to your search, narrow results further by selecting a Leaking UST project type. Other alternative ways to narrow data is by searching by county, zip code, or visually navigating to the area of interest using the alternative search method below. If you are interested in multiple types of environmental sites leave the project type and environmental interest blank or select multiple project types/environmental interests.
