Where are permittees located?

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality issues water quality permits, called National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits, to regulate the pollutant levels in wastewater and stormwater discharges. DEQ issues both general and individual NPDES permits. General permits are for groups of similar facilities. Individual permits are for more complex facilities requiring specific regulations to ensure water quality is protected.

This map below shows Oregon and each county within it. Within each county, there are blue dots that signify NPDES individual permit locations. This map shows most of the permits assigned coverage for informational purposes, however, it may be missing some facilities or outfall locations may have changes without an update on this map.

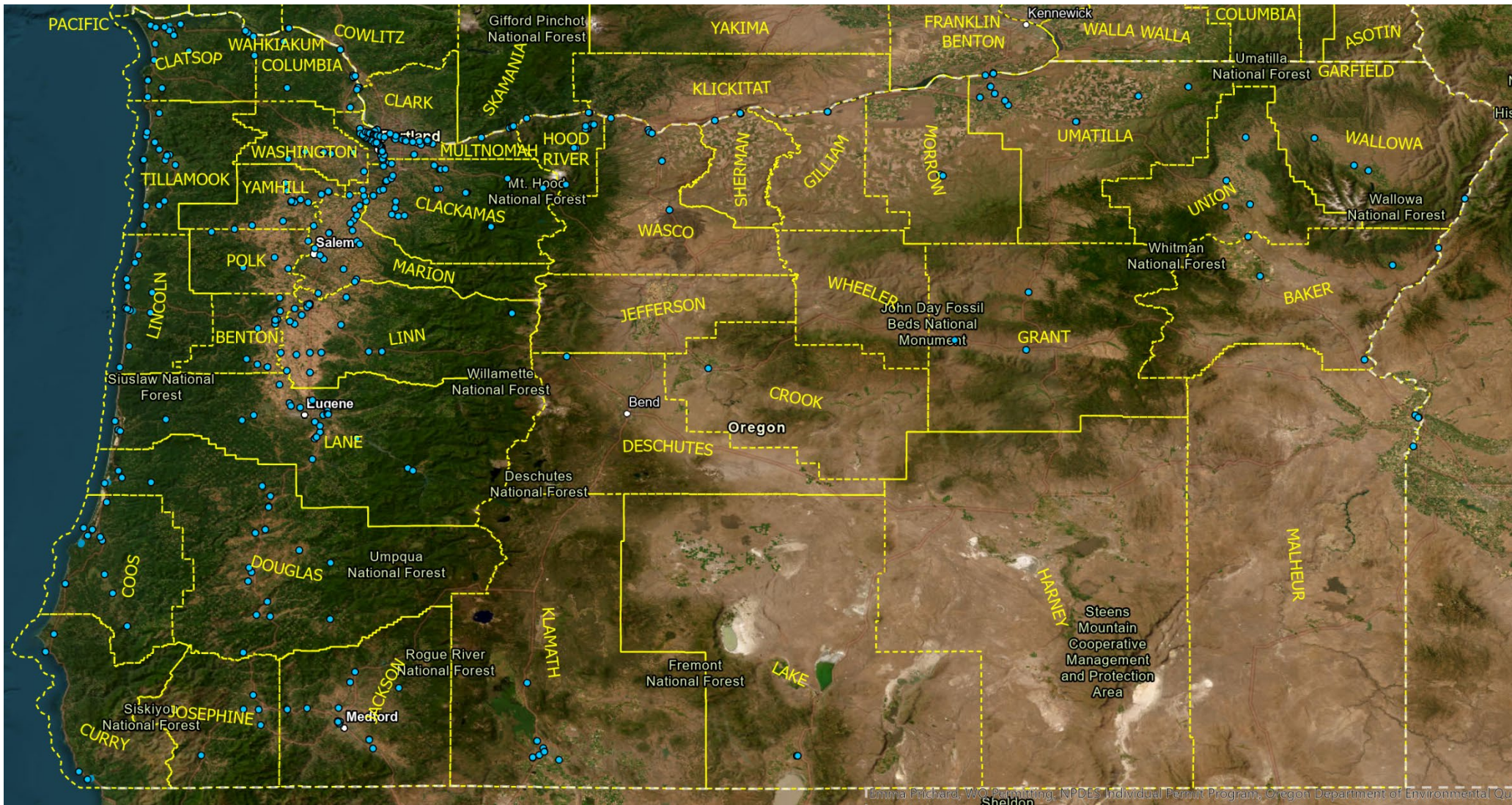
