How Many Sites Covered Statewide?

WPCF 1000: 83 permit registrants (DOGAMI 53)

NPDES 1200-A: 190 (DOGAMI 153) permit registrants

Approximately discharge into 40 distinct water bodies



What are Some of the Proposed Changes?

WPCF 1000

- Updated to new template
- Standardize and improve definitions

NPDES 1200-A

- Regulate process water, mine dewatering and stormwater
- Add natural buffer and erosion and sediment control requirements during earth disturbing activities



What are Some of the Proposed Changes?

NPDES 1200-A

- Incorporate EPA's sector conditions (Sector J)
- Incorporate some 1200-Z conditions
- Evaluate monitoring
- Add pH numeric effluent limit for process water
- Clarify active vs. inactive mining operation requirements
