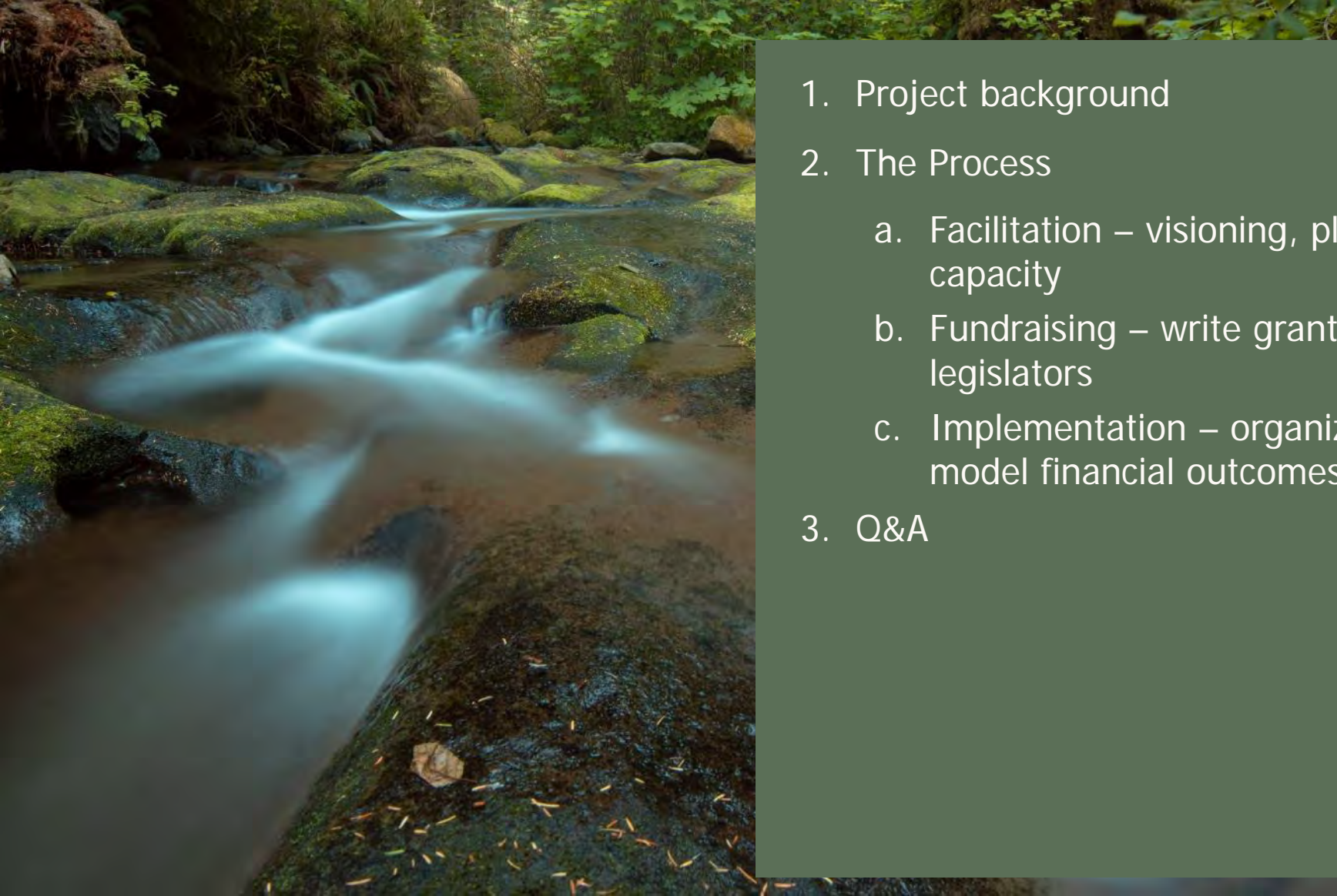

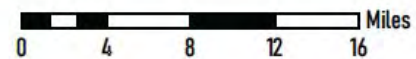

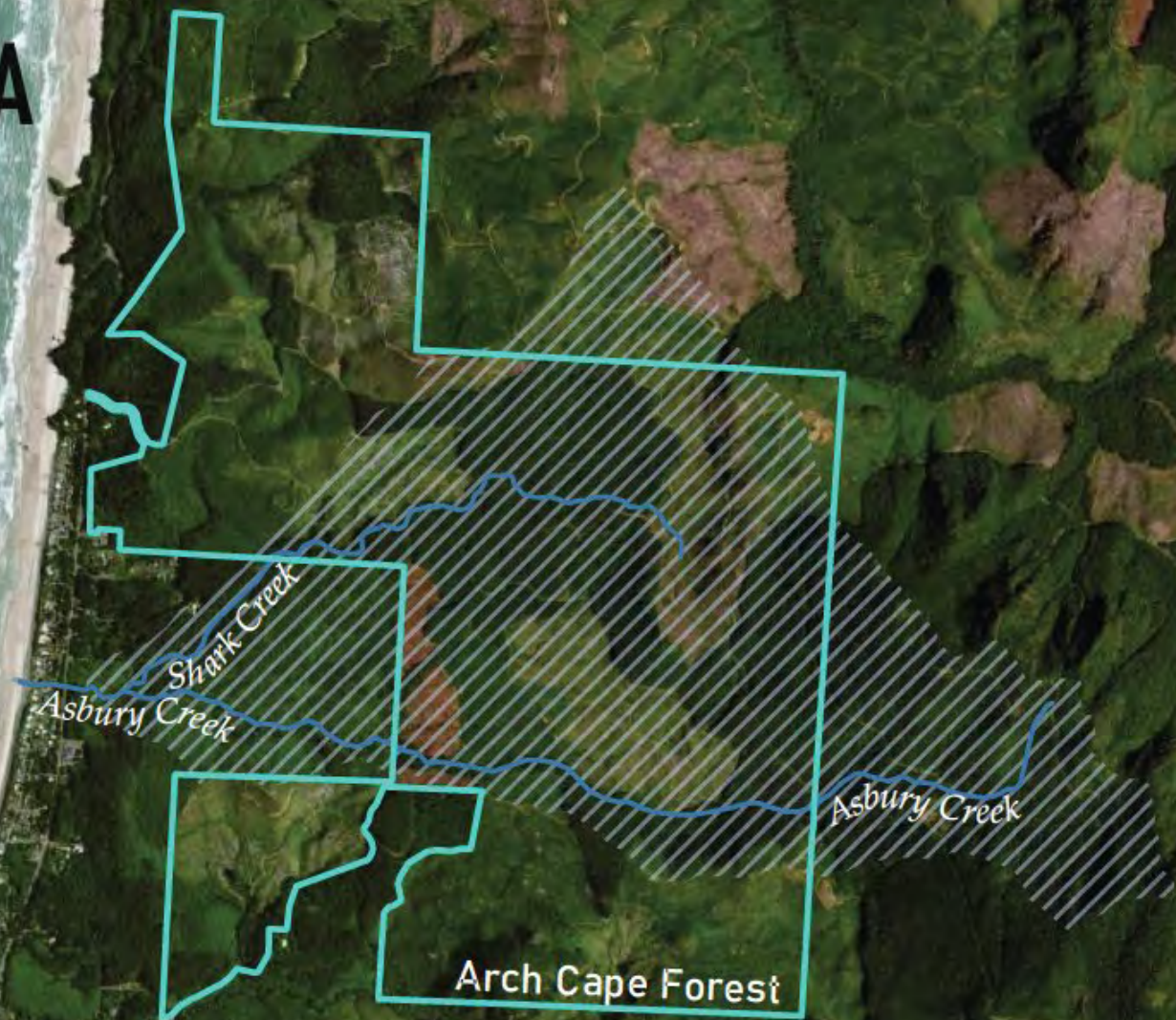
# AREA MAP

Map: Forest Legacy Application 2018 for FY2020

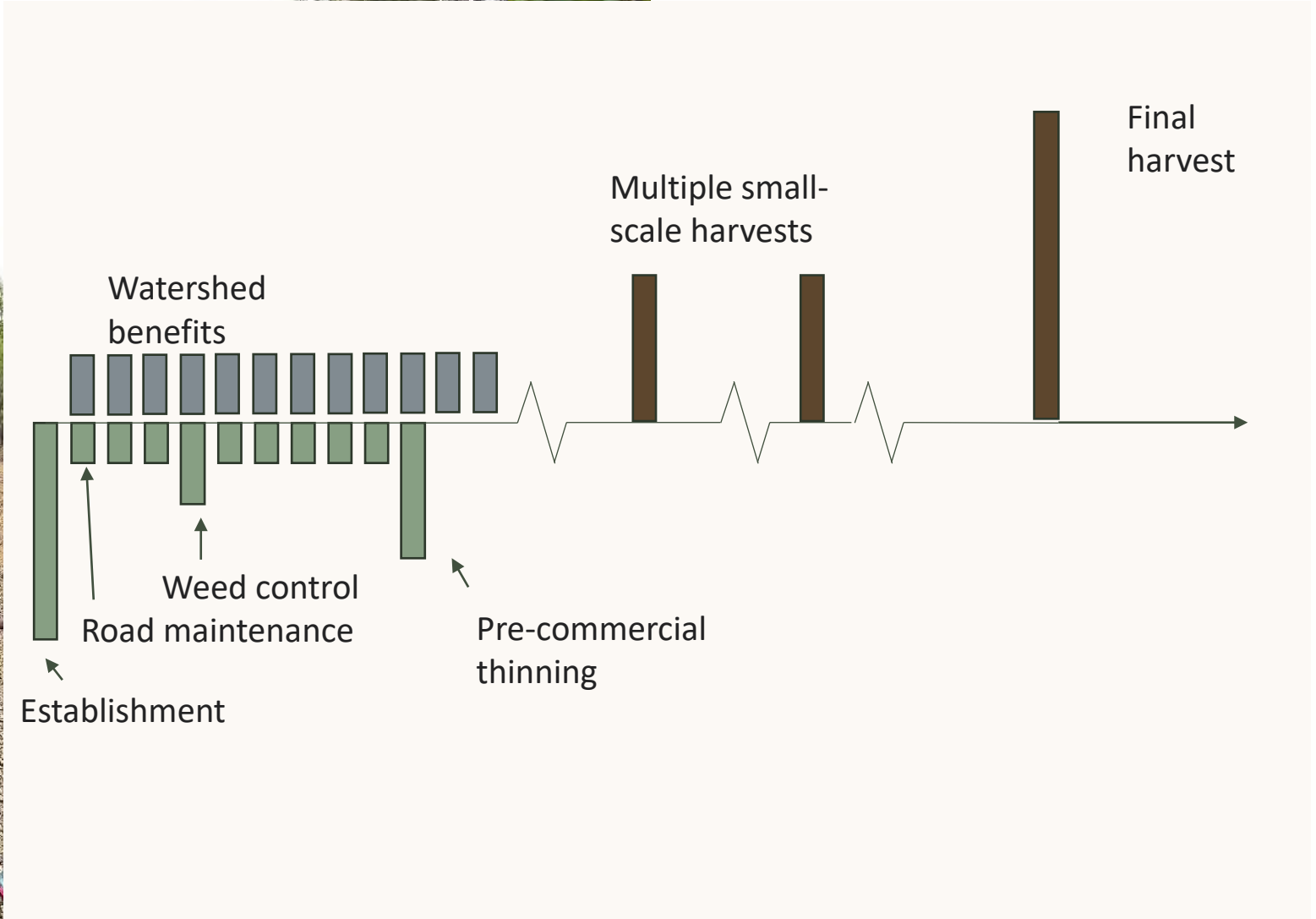

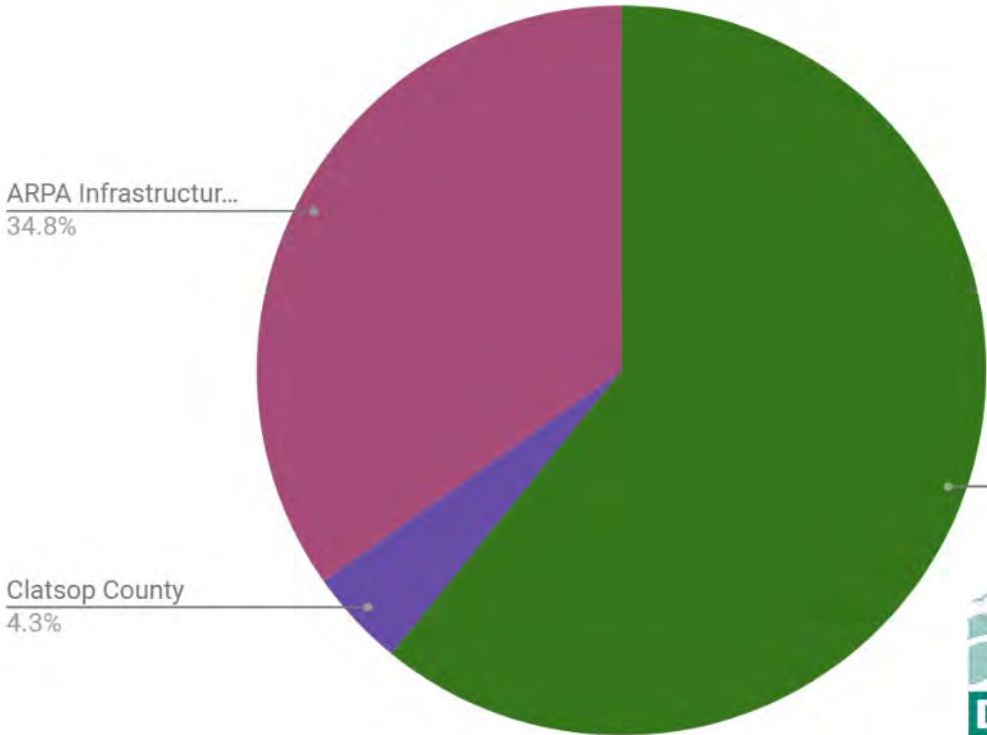

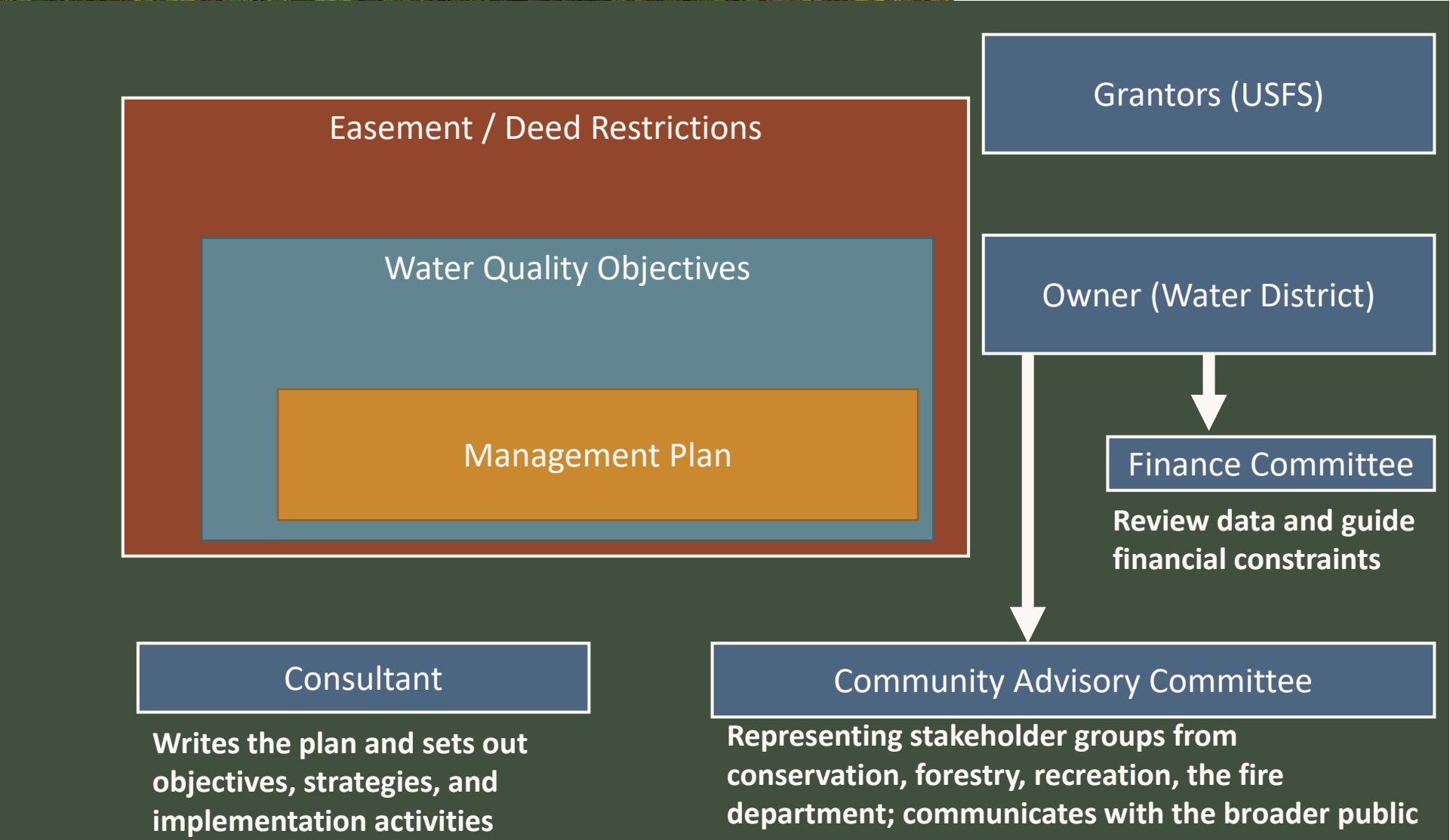
