 - Wildfire recovery
 - Dry pasture

What TA Services Can Jackson SWCD Offer?

- Agricultural & Irrigation Technical Assistance
 - Pasture restoration
 - Invasive species treatment
 - Fence rebuilding
 - Ag structures that protect water quality (manure storage, sacrifice pastures)
 - Irrigation infrastructure

- Forestry & RiparianTechnical Assistance

Funding Resources

- JSWCD Conservation Assistance Program
 - Free seed and straw
 - No-cost herbicide treatment (Almeda only through RVCOG)
 - ODF forestry crew for hazard tree removal, slash treatment
 - While supplies last
- New fiscal year July 2021, hope to continue to prioritize post-fire projects
- Equipment Rental Program
 - Seeding equipment
 - Free for post-fire recovery work



Funding Resources

- Oregon Watershed
 Enhancement Board (OWEB)
 Wildfire Response Grant
 - \$75k for South Obenchain
 - Hazard tree and slash treatment
 - Riparian herbicide treatment
 - Riparian fencing
 - Must work through JSWCD, prioritizing work
 - Similar grant for Almeda Drive, work through RRWC



Funding Resources

- FSA
 - Number of livestock and crop assistance programs
 - Emergency Forest Restoration Program (EFRP)
 - Low interest loans
- NRCS
 - Western Oregon Wildfire Emergency Stabilization
 - Deadline past, but future funding possible
- FSA is a first stop for all landowners
