# Forestry Resources in Oregon

Source water protection for drinking water resources in Oregon can include forest management plans and land or land easement acquisition. Foresters who specialize in ecologically/water quality-based forest management in Oregon may be helpful to prepare for these types of projects. DEQ, in consultation with the Society of American Foresters and other regional partners, has created this preliminary list of forest professionals who have participated in the past or who have expressed interest participating in the future on projects centered on natural resource protection and Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) standards. Note that there is no FSC certification for foresters, just for forestland and forest products, so there is no list of "FSC Foresters." Learn more about FSC here: <https://fsc.org/en>
