## 2020-21 School Year Drop-in Article

Your school can use a drop-in article to get information to your families:

- In print or electronic newsletters
- By email
- In a flyer

There are two versions to choose from:

- One for schools participating in the [Community Eligibility Provision \(CEP\)](#) program
- One for non-CEP schools

#### Grocery money for summer meals for students

#### Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) is coming soon!

Is your student eligible for free or reduced-price school meals? Then your student may be eligible for P-EBT. P-EBT is money for buying food at home for students. Oregon is sending P-EBT to families with eligible students this summer. The grocery money is to make-up for meals students missed while schools and childcare were closed part-time or full-time during the 2020-21 school year. You can still get “grab-and-go” or summer meals from the school while receiving P-EBT.

#### Find out if your student is eligible and how P-EBT works

If your student was already approved for free or reduced-price school meals this school year or your family receives SNAP, you don't need to apply for P-EBT. Your family will automatically receive P-EBT starting in July.

If your family receives SNAP, the P-EBT money will be added to your account. If your family does not receive SNAP, make sure the school has your family's current mailing address because the state will send you an EBT card by mail.

If things have changed for your family and your student may now be eligible for free or reduced-price school meals, there is still time to apply!

#### Grocery money for summer meals for students

## **Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) is coming soon!**

Our school offers all meals at no charge to students and that means all students will automatically receive P-EBT starting in July. P-EBT is money for buying food at home for students during the summer. Oregon will send the grocery money to families to make-up for meals students missed while schools and childcare were closed part-time or full-time during the 2020-21 school year. You can still get “grab-and-go” or summer meals from the school while receiving P-EBT.
