

Data for April 2020 are the most recent 'final actuals' as of the September 2020 monthly update. The Total Child Welfare caseload for April 2020 is 0.2 percent higher than the Fall 2020 forecast.





Subsidized Guardianship provides an option for individuals who do not wish to adopt but would like to offer a permanent home for children who would otherwise be in foster care.






