Burst water pipe requires closure of some state offices in Pendleton, reopening Wednesday at temporary locations

(Salem, Ore.) — A burst water pipe caused flooding in the offices of the Oregon Department of Human Services at 800 SE Emigrant, Pendleton.

The facility is being repaired and service locations have temporarily been relocated.
