

Some browsers display the “Please wait...” message because their built-in PDF viewer can’t display dynamic forms. However, you can still download the form to your computer and open it using Adobe Reader or Acrobat DC. **Note for Apple users, it is important that you have Adobe Reader**

1. Click on the form link.
2. If you get a message that says “Please wait...”, click on the download button. The button is usually on the top right of the page and looks like a floppy disk or a document with a downward arrow.
 - a. Depending on which browser you use, you may be prompted to choose where the file will be saved or it may save automatically to your “downloads” folder.
3. Find the form in your files and open it using Adobe Reader or Acrobat DC.
4. If you double click the form and it opens in the browser again:
 - a. Right click the form you saved and choose “Open with”
 - b. Choose either Adobe Reader or Acrobat DC from the menu.
5. **Apple Users: Download the profile to your files then open it. Make sure you have Adobe Reader installed**
