This alert is being sent to:

- Share guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on how to prevent the spread of infection in long-term care facilities.
- Remind providers about their obligation to have an alternative staffing plan.

In addition, the Department wants to advise providers to regularly check the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) website which posts updates on emerging respiratory infections for novel coronavirus (COVID-19) within the state of Oregon. The website also includes statistics about the number of individuals who have been, or are, currently being monitored for COVID-19, the number of individuals who have tested positive, negative, and who have tests pending:
