Topic: **CPR & First Aid Certificates No Longer Accepted**

It has come to the attention of the Department that some online CPR and first aid vendors are not requiring an in-person skills competency check prior to issuing a certificate of completion. Any vendor not requiring an in-person skills competency check, should be reported to the Department.

Please be advised we will no longer accept CPR and first aid certifications from [CPR Heart Center online](#). CPR Heart Center does not require an in-person skills competency check prior to issuing a certificate of completion. The Adult Foster Home (AFH) Oregon Administrative rules require an in-person skills competency check be completed and passed in order to meet the qualifications to work in an AFH.
