RE: Indoor visitation prohibited from Nov. 11-25 in Jackson, Malheur, Marion, Multnomah and Umatilla counties

Governor Kate Brown has announced new measures to help stop the rapid spread of COVID-19 in counties where community transmission is on the rise. These measures include prohibiting indoor visitation at all long-term care facilities from Nov. 11 through Nov. 25, 2020, in the following counties:

- Jackson
- Malheur
- Marion
- Multnomah
- Umatilla

The two-week prohibition is being instituted in counties with a case rate above 200 cases per 100,000 people over a two-week period, or more than 60 cases over a two-week period for counties with less than 30,000.

Facilities in the above five counties must comply with Governor Brown's order. Please note that this policy change does not affect [compassionate care visitation](#) or the [limited outdoor visitation policy](#).
