- Ongoing COVID-19 Identification and Treatment
- Post-Vaccination Practices
- Vaccination and Testing (Ongoing Compliance)

Sessions will include local data and COVID updates, content on the topics above, quality improvement, discussion and breakouts.

A bonus 30 minutes from 2:30-3:00 P.T. will be optional and focus on group coaching, deeper discussion of key questions and topical breakouts.
