I am writing to request and encourage the participation of key CDDP and Brokerage staff in an upcoming readiness survey for the Centralized Abuse Management (CAM) project.

We want people to never experience abuse and neglect. When it does happen, it is crucial we be able to take appropriate action and get data from the system to make decisions and plan.

When complete, CAM will be a comprehensive web-based system for the documentation of abuse reports and investigations. The ODDS serious events reporting system is also being rolled into this project. CAM will improve and standardize DHS and OHA abuse reports across multiple populations, replace manual processes and outdated, disparate systems to provide better protection to vulnerable Oregonians.

CAM is important to all of us working in the I/DD system and ultimately to the individuals we support.

CDDP and Brokerage directors will soon receive an email from the Centralized Abuse Management project team. It will request that CDDP and Brokerage Directors, as well as their protective services and SERT supervisors, complete the survey within two weeks.
