Subject: Important survey begins soon

Next week, employees of Community Developmental Disabilities Programs (CDDPs) and Brokerages will begin receiving the Random Moment Survey.

The information you provide will establish a basis for funding requests in the 2023–25 biennium and enable the Oregon Department of Human Service (ODHS) to accurately predict the employment and budget needs of Oregon’s CDDPs and Brokerages.

- Please complete the survey three times weekly.
- The process continues through February 2022.
- Surveys should take no longer than one minute to complete.
- The research team will aggregate and anonymize all survey results. Employees’ identities will be protected and unknown in the published reports.
- The only people with access to the survey’s raw data are members of the ORRAI research team specifically assigned to the project. No one in leadership positions, such as managers and supervisors, will have access to the raw data.
