Subject: Staffing shortage assistance for I/DD adult foster homes

As part of our overall efforts to ensure people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) can remain safely in their current homes while staffing issues remain a challenge, the Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS) has initiated a contract with a healthcare staffing company to bring in staff to support adult foster homes for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD).

ODDS is using the survey data provided by I/DD adult foster home providers (Thank you to those who filled out the survey!) to identify homes in need and is prioritizing based on survey response time, severity of need and the number of staff available by the contractor in that area.

ODDS will call provider agencies in need of staff to gather additional information. When staff are available and assigned to a home, ODDS will initiate a contract with the receiving provider. These contracts:

- Are initially for 30 days, with an option to extend an additional 30 days upon request.
- Will expire Dec. 31, 2021.
- Require I/DD adult foster care providers to train contracted staff to work in their homes.
- Require providers to follow current ODDS [Reopening Guidance](#).

Prior to receiving support, providers must sign an agreement letter. An example of the letter is [online](#).
