Subject: iLearn to Workday Transition

This message is to inform all Office of Developmental Disabilities Services (ODDS) partners and stakeholders, including case management entities and providers, that the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) is transitioning from iLearn Oregon to Workday Learning, with an anticipated date of June 2021.

This means that all future trainings required by ODDS and the Oregon Department of Human Services, including core competencies, will be on the Workday Learning platform instead of iLearn. We want to inform case management entities, providers and other stakeholders now so you can begin preparing.

ODDS is still learning more about how this transition will happen, and how it will impact our providers and case management entities. We will continue to update you with resources and information as we find out.

For now, we ask that you begin the process by saving all your training information currently in iLearn. ODDS has learned that training transcripts in iLearn possibly may not be moved over to Workday. It is critical that all providers and CMEs save your required training transcripts for your personnel files for each staff member. We have attached instructions on how to save your transcripts in iLearn.
