Subject: Summer Hours Update

As we head into a new school year, the Office of Developmental Disabilities Services wants to update families and case management entities about summer hours.

Summer hours listed on Children's Needs Assessments (CNAs) will continue to be in effect for children receiving in-home services or Children's Intensive In-Home Services (CIIS). Attendant care hours may be used at any time of day as determined by the child's parent/guardian, due to the unique nature of this school year. Attendant care may be used for any Activity of Daily Living (ADL), Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADL), health-related, or behavior support tasks identified in the child's ISP. Attendant care should not be used for educational activities or homeschooling.

ODDS will give plenty of advance notice when summer hours do end, although we don't anticipate rolling this back until the end of the federal public health emergency.
