Subject: Youth and family voices needed for council

The [System of Care Advisory Council](#) is looking for two new members to contribute youth and family voices. The 25-person council meets monthly, has other committees and workgroups, and involves a time commitment of at least five to six hours per month.

The open seats are designated for:

- A member of the public who is a family member of a child with an intellectual or developmental disability or a mental illness.
- A member of the public who is 25 years old or younger and has either been in foster care or a youth offender, as those terms are defined in [ORS 419A.004](#).

A stipend is available for these two members if they are not being paid for their time or have an income of less than \$50,000 for the previous tax year.
