Subject: Quarterly report for SB 710

[Senate Bill 710](#) (SB 710) went into effect Sept. 1, 2021. The bill regulates the use of restraint and involuntary seclusion of children who receive services across several agencies including the Office of Developmental Disabilities Services' (ODDS) children's settings. The bill added new reporting requirements for each Host Home and Children's Residential program in ODDS.
