If you didn't fill out the survey, ODDS still needs your input. To understand the current state of the work undertaken by supported living provider agencies, ODDS needs your most up-to-date data. With input from some of your agencies, Burns & Associates, a division of Health Management Associates, developed the survey to gather information regarding supported living provider agencies' caseloads, service designs and staffing patterns.

While voluntary, this survey will help ODDS review the approach to paying for supported living services. If your agency does not participate, your ability to inform the outcome of the rate models will be limited.
