Subject: 5% COVID-19 rate increase ending soon

In June 2022, [ODDS announced](#) a 90-day extension of the emergency 5% COVID-19 rate increase for a number of services.

Services receiving the rate increase include:

- Professional behavior services
- Children's foster care
- Child and adult group homes
- Host Homes
- Day support activities
- Employment

This temporary extension expires Sept. 30, 2022. This is a reminder that this increase is scheduled to end at the end of this month.
