What is Small Group Supported Employment?

Small Group Supported Employment opportunities are services and activities where the group (fewer than 8 people) works as a crew or workgroup.

Through Small Group Supported Employment, people will have regular opportunities to interact with the community and obtain valuable skills that can be applied toward their career goals in the future.

The purpose of small group supported employment is to help someone eventually get individual integrated employment.

Example:

Chris works with a team of individuals who are supported together to gain skills for finding their individual jobs.

Chris is supported by his team and his coach to be more independent and learn new tasks.

He meets and interacts with people with and without disabilities and works on his interactions with others in order to build relationships.
