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## Overview

### **The purpose of this worker's guide is to:**

Outline information and requirements related to 1:1 Employment Path Services. This service is intended to support individuals to obtain individualized community work experiences.

### **Procedure(s) that apply:**

#### **Service Requirements:**

- A. Individuals must have a specific goal outlined in the Career Development Plan.
- B. This service must be used in a general community business setting, and not at a provider site.
- C. The service must be intended to support the person to obtain competitive integrated employment.
- D. The support should be work related, and not attendant care supports. The provider is expected to meet the person's attendant and personal care support needs.
- E. This 1:1 Employment Path Service must be provided in a 1:1 setting, and may not be delivered in a group setting. For services in a group setting, consider using other employment service options.

#### **Limitations:**

- 1:1 Employment Path Services may be used for up to 50 hours per year.
- The 1:1 Employment Path Service is also subject a limit of 25 hours for a combination of Employment Services.
