Action required: ODDS is exploring possible options to support people who experience intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) who are also parents of children (with or without disabilities). ODDS requests that case management entities (CMEs) identify a staff member to take this short 3-minute survey so that the department may collect information to help assess for interest.

Information being requested in the survey includes: the approximate number of people on your caseload who are parents themselves, and approximately how many might be interested in accessing this type of service.

Reason for action: ODDS is exploring possible options to support parents with IDD to support their children. The options may include 1:1 support for parenting tasks, skill building, and other support needs outside of the scope of K-plan attendant care. As ODDS goes through the exploration process the department will work in partnership with community members and partners. CMEs have vital information on who may have

interest in and benefit from this potential service. This is just a preliminary step and does not replace the robust stakeholder input process needed to fully explore service options for parents with IDD.
