The Oregon Legislature has allocated funds to provide air conditioning (AC) units to Medicaid recipients and Medicaid eligible individuals at highest risk for heat related illness. ODDS is partnering with the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and the Office of Resilience and Emergency Management (OREM) to coordinate requests for individuals to receive an AC unit. OHA has a limited supply of air conditioners for vulnerable people. This summer we estimate having 4,000 devices available for Oregonians. Case Management Entities (CMEs) may [submit a request](#) for individuals who live in their own home or family home (in unlicensed residential settings) and fall within set cohorts to receive an AC unit. An individual does not have to meet each cohort to be considered for an AC unit. The cohorts can be found in the request form that is linked above.

Currently, OHA and OREM can provide AC units to those within the cohorts identified

above and do not have centralized AC in their home or have AC that is not effectively working. The types of AC units that are available connect to a window but sit on the floor. There may be different types of AC units that are available depending on the availability of those units. Expected delivery dates will vary, estimated timeframes are not able to be given at this time. The team working on this is working as diligently as possible and are requesting that case managers be mindful of the numbers of calls being made for status updates.

There is currently no deadline for requests nor a finite number of air conditioning units that will be available to the State. Thus, there will be ongoing opportunities for individuals to inquire about receiving one.
