Action Required:

New CPMS codes for Service Elements 49, 149, and 151 became effective July 1, 2014 and must be used to report claims and data for the following time periods:

September 2014 and on-going: The new codes attached to this transmittal **must be** used to report all services delivered on and after September 1, 2014. Please do not use OR codes for reporting to TNT. OR codes are only to be used in Plan of Care.

August 2014 CPMS claims for services - if you have **not yet** reported August services through CPMS, please use the new codes and indicate when submitting them that the new codes are being used.

July 2014 and August 2014 services - for claims that have **already been** submitted to TNT and or the Technical Assistance Unit (TAU), ODDS will work directly with you and TNT/TAU to crosswalk the old codes with the new codes. You do not need to resubmit any data, however, it may take longer than normal for the CDDPs or brokerages to see the data on their greenbars. ODDS will be unable to determine the appropriate CPMS code for services authorized under 726 unless each brokerage adds a comment in the notes section identifying the appropriate service.

The updated CPMS codes are captured in the DRAFT Expenditure Guidelines and also attached to this email. TNT will submit all CPMS entries for the DHS contracted

services paid July 1, 2014 forward. This will include the June services paid by TNT.

****Please review the new codes carefully as they may at first appear to be unchanged.****

Reason for Action:

New services became available in the Comprehensive, Support Services and CIIS Behavior and Medically Fragile Waivers on July 1, 2014. In order to accurately report the service that was received, new CPMS codes have been created to accurately capture the available waiver and k-plan services.
