SE51 Supported Living Budget Tool 2020 must be implemented for all Supported Living Budgets beginning July 1, 2020 and any previous versions of SE51 Supported Living Budget Tool deleted. Supported living budgets created prior to 7/1/20 include this increase.

Reason for action: The Supported Living Budget Tool has been revised to add a legislatively approved 5% rate increase to Supported Living (SE51) rates, effective July 1, 2020.
