Message: Until further notice, roll out of the eXPRS Plan of Care (POC) implementation will exclude Behavior Consultation (BC) services delivered to children and adults in foster care settings. This means that payment for BC services rendered will not be paid through POC. The current process for payment of BC services remains as follows:

Funds for BC services will continue to be added into the assessed SNAP service payment rate. Foster care providers remain responsible for hiring and directly paying qualified consultants to provide BC services for children and adults in foster care settings.
