The In home Expenditure Guidelines v.4 has been posted here http://www.dhs.state.or.us/spd/tools/dd/cm/ss_exp_guide.pdf can be accessed from the staff tools pages. This replaces the In Home Expenditure Guidelines v.3 and applies to services authorized for delivery beginning January 1, 2016.

Updates include:

- Alignment with the 2015-17 Collective Bargaining Agreement by adjusting the PSW rates and eliminating items related to PSW Independent Contractors (for information about the transition of PSW Independent Contractors (see [AR-15-067](#)).
- Removal of references to hourly relief care.
- Increasing certain agency rates by 4%, consistent with direction from the Legislature.
