Message:

On May 27, 2016, both the DD Eligibility & Enrollment (0337) and the eXPRS DD eligibility view screen will contain new diagnosis codes and definitions; further some of the current diagnosis codes and definitions will be converted. The changes will reflect current terminology as well as new diagnoses used by qualified professionals. The changes are outlined below.

These modifications to the DD Eligibility & Enrollment (0337) and eXPRS view screen are necessary to: remove outdated DD terminology; update codes to reflect current diagnoses used by qualified professionals; and to simplify our analysis of IDD conditions and eligibility trends.

The eXPRS view screen also has a new "hover" feature. If the user hovers over an eligibility code on the view screen, the code's definition will appear. For example, the definition "Mild Intellectual Disability" will pop-out whenr the user hovers over the eligibility code "ID1."

eXPRS user assistance guides have also been updated to reflect this new information, and are available on the eXPRS [Help Menu](#).

New Diagnosis Codes and Definitions			
<u>Code</u>		<u>Definition</u>	<u>Use of code</u>
ECA	=	Early Childhood Assessment	This code should be used when a child's eligibility is based on a standardized-and-normed early-childhood assessment under OAR 411-320-0080(5)(a)(A)(i). Redetermination is due by age 9.
OGC	=	Other Genetic Condition	This code should be used when an individual's eligibility is based on a neurodevelopmental disorder associated with a genetic condition under OAR 411-320-0080(4). Eligibility specialists must check with the D&E before using this code. If the individual is school-age, redetermination is due by age 22.
SZD	=	Seizure Disorder	This code should be used when an individual's eligibility is based on seizure disorder under OAR 411-320-0080(4). If the individual is school-age, redetermination is due by age 22.
TRS	=	Tourette's Disorder	This code should be used when an individual's eligibility is based on Tourette's Disorder under OAR 411-320-0080(4). If the individual is school-age, redetermination is due by age 22.

Conversion of Current Diagnosis Codes and Definitions						
<u>Code</u>		<u>Definition</u>		<u>New Code</u>		<u>New Definition</u>
MR1	=	Mild Mental Retardation	→	ID1	=	Mild Intellectual Disability
MR2	=	Moderate Mental Retardation	→	ID2	=	Moderate Intellectual Disability
MR3	=	Severe Mental Retardation	→	ID3	=	Severe Intellectual Disability
MR4	=	Profound Mental Retardation	→	ID4	=	Profound Intellectual Disability
ADR	=	Alcohol/Drug Related Neurodevelopmental disorder/Spectrum	→	FAS	=	Fetal Alcohol Syndrome <u>or</u> Neurodevelopmental disorder associated with prenatal drug or alcohol exposure
FAE	=	Fetal Alcohol Effects	→	FAS	=	Fetal Alcohol Syndrome <u>or</u> Neurodevelopmental disorder associated with prenatal drug or alcohol exposure

FAS	=	Fetal Alcohol Syndrome	→	FAS	=	Fetal Alcohol Syndrome <u>or</u> Neurodevelopmental disorder associated with prenatal drug or alcohol exposure
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Note: The DD Eligibility & Enrollment (337) already includes term “intellectual disability” rather than “mental retardation”, but the eXPRS view screen currently still contains the outdated code.
