Services Coordinators should be aware that 24-Hour Residential agencies who anticipate delivering Professional Behavior Services after the Burns & Associates rate models are implemented (anticipated 01/01/2021) must become endorsed and enrolled to OAR 411-304. In March 2020, ODDS will be communicating with all 24-Hour Residential agencies who are not endorsed to deliver Professional Behavior Services and reminding them that they will need to have an endorsement and be enrolled to deliver Professional Behavior Services following the implementation of the Burns & Associates rate models, should they choose to deliver that service.

Services Coordinators do not need to take any action at this time to assist with the endorsement and enrollment of 24-Hour Residential services providers to the Professional Behavior Services Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 411-304. For additional information see AR 1029:
