

**Health Systems Division
Home and Community-Based (HCBS)
Provider Initial Status Report**

Providers of residential Home and Community-Based Services, Adult Foster Home (AFH), Residential Treatment Facility (RTF), and Residential Treatment Home (RTH) programs are expected to meet new Federal and Oregon expectations for Home and Community-Based Services by September 2018.

Generally providers are adjusting their policies to make their residences as personalized and homelike as possible. New policies focus on the resident's access to the broader community, freedom to control one's own schedule, the right to privacy, access to food and visitors, and more. Important Points:

- Providers licensed prior to January 2016 do not need to meet these expectations until September 2018. Provider licensed after January 2017 will not have regulatory findings until January 2017. All providers listed are currently licensed and meet current expectations.
- This status report is a moment in time and a setting may have changed since the provider submitted their survey. Settings will continue to change as providers learn about HCBS and work toward meeting the HCBS expectations by the September 2018 compliance deadline.
- Consumers should not use this list as the only information source in shopping for an HCBS-compliant setting.
- This information will be updated on a quarterly basis, and will be based on reports provided by Licensors following regular licensing visits.
