

**Home and Community-Based (HCBS)
Provider Initial Status Report
Office of Developmental Disabilities Services (ODDS) Providers**

Providers of Home and Community-Based Services in residential and non-residential service settings: Foster Care, 24-Hour Residential Programs, some Support Living situations, and facility-based day and employment settings are expected to meet new Federal and Oregon expectations for Home and Community-Based Services by September 1, 2018.

Generally, providers are making improvements and adjusting their policies to meet new HCBS requirements. New policies focus on the individual's access to the broader community, freedom to control one's own schedule, the right to privacy, access to food and visitors, and more. This page lists all Oregon HCBS providers who receive funding through ODDS for residential and non-residential settings and their status of compliance with the new HCBS rules based on the individual and provider surveys and/or on-site compliance assessments.

Important Points:

- Providers licensed prior to January 2016 have until September 1, 2018 to meet full compliance.
- This status report represents a moment in time assessment and a setting's status may have changed since the provider submitted their survey or undergone an on-site review. Settings will continue to change as providers learn about HCBS and work toward meeting the HCBS expectations by the September 1, 2018 compliance deadline.
- Individuals and families should not use this list as the only information source in determining which are HCBS compliant settings. Individuals are encouraged to communicate with their local CDDP Services Coordinator or Personal Agent for more information on HCBS options.

- This information will be updated on a quarterly basis, and will be based on reports provided by on-going on-site reviews.
