Vaccine Scheduling Instructions Group Notice for Clinics on January 29, 2021 For Phase 1A (High/Med/Low Risk)

Pre-Screening Form:

- Review this OHA Vaccine Admin Record in advance; if possible, print this form, complete it, and bring it with you...if not you will fill it out at the vaccine clinic during your appointment.

Scheduling Process:

- o Use the links below, to schedule yourself or your staff for their appointment:
 - Newport Area Jan. 29th (Moderna First Dose Only) https://sugeni.us/WTJG
- There may not be enough vaccine appointments, during this group of clinics for all your staff to be scheduled. More clinics will be scheduled and communicated to you as the vaccine becomes available.
- o Email confirmation and text/email reminders will be sent from the scheduling program.
- You must be available for your 2nd dose for the vaccine you receive...if you cannot be available do not get the first dose.

• Day of Appointment Process:

- Wear a short sleeve shirt and your face covering.
- Bring your agency name badge/photo identification with you to your appointment. Photo ID
 will be required to validate your appointment; independent care workers should bring standard
 government identification card (driver license, identification card, passport).
- Total appointment time is approximately 30 minutes; arrive 10 minutes ahead of time with your face covering. You will receive your vaccine and then be asked to wait for a 15-minute observation period before you can leave your appointment.
- You will receive a vaccine card with your info and your vaccine entered in the State immunization program for future reference. Staff at the vaccine clinic will schedule you for your 2nd dose appointment so bring your calendar with you if needed.
- Vaccine Appointment Location the location of the vaccine clinic will be in the scheduling program
 confirmation that you will receive.

• Financial Considerations:

There is no cost to the staff or residents for this vaccine.
