

Malheur County Vaccine Information

The Malheur County Health Department and Incident Command team will host an indoor COVID-19 vaccine POD (point of distribution) at the Four Rivers Cultural Center. Those wanting to be vaccinated are asked to wait until 9 a.m. before lining up. The POD is open to Phase 1a and Phase 1b-Group 1. Vaccine recipients must live or work in Malheur County.

This POD will distribute roughly 350 first doses of the Moderna vaccine on a first-come, first-served basis. The vaccination event will go until about 2p.m., or as long as vaccines last. There is no out-of-pocket cost for the vaccine. Administration fees will be billed to insurance; please bring your insurance card(s). You are also asked to wear a mask.

Please use the south entrance of the cultural center, near the theater. The back parking lot, located between the cultural center and TVCC's Weese Building, will provide the closest access. Several wheelchairs will be available for use. Although the event takes place indoors, participants will likely be required to stand in line outdoors for a period of time. Please dress according to the weather and bring an umbrella for added protection from the elements. Saturday's weather forecast currently calls for snow.
