

Multnomah County Vaccine Information

There are drive-through COVID-19 vaccine appointments available for scheduling at the OHSU vaccine clinic located at the **Portland International Airport** for Phase 1a eligible individuals who meet one of the two following criteria:

You are paid or unpaid caregiver (includes family members or foster parents) of medically fragile children or adults, or people with disabilities who live at home.

You receive at-home services for a medical condition or disability

Appointments are available for Saturday and Sunday, 2/6 and 2/7. These are appointments for first doses only. People who need a second dose should contact the location where they received their first dose.

Please be aware that even though you might be eligible, appointments may be filled quickly. Once appointments are full for the week you will have to try again the next week. We apologize and ask for your patience.

An appointment is required for a vaccination at this event. Due to limited vaccine supply, people without an appointment cannot be accommodated.
