Class reports and certifications reports: Roberta gave a highlight of the certification and class reports; noting that additional courses are being offered via Webinar.

Family caregiver as paid provider: discussion regarding the next steps, which include consumer input and a follow up meeting with community partners to take place soon.

PACE update: PACE contract is now live, and the programmers are working at creating a “store front” for workers so that when they sign in, they will be able to clearly identify our program. A “certification dashboard” will be created so workers will be able to see what progress they have made towards earning their certifications.

Registry updates: Registry rollout took place on April 9th; the rollout requires each account to have a unique email. Our customer service team has been working towards assisting workers and consumers with navigating the Registry. Those workers with multiple specialties will need to now have a unique email for each account.

Challenging behavior updates: OHCC is working with some experts on behavior and are looking at updating the Challenging Behavior courses; the course will be looking through the lens of APD and ODDS and include both HCW and PSWs.
