**PACE Overview:** Roberta and Dale presented the latest efforts for the OSU PACE initiative. The expiration of iLearn has allowed OHCC to offer three courses (Keeping it Professional, Fighting Fraud and Abuse, and Working Together) through the OSU PACE platform. PACE testing has been completed by the OHCC training group. Included in each are the course materials, online class, and assessment. The current goal is to open registration on PACE in the latter part of July. As was reported earlier, two additional classes are planned for inclusion following the rollout.

**Enhanced Certification – Readiness Assessment:** Dale Mayuiers shared that an online version of the Readiness Assessment using the Alchemer application is ready for use. The Readiness Assessment gives workers the opportunity to obtain the Enhanced Certification while providing a more efficient method of reporting for OHCC.

**Family Caregiver Paid Provider course update:** Meeting to summarize course with caregivers will be arranged in the coming months. Following meeting OHCC Training Team will begin development work on course materials. Second half of August meeting will be devoted to addressing the course.

**Better Serving Aging Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders:** David shared latest updates to the prospect of providing training appropriate for aging individuals who identify as Asian and Pacific Rim individuals.

**Challenging Behaviors:** Consideration is being given to creating a course to address challenging behaviors found in the IDD community and aging individuals.
