System Updates

Looking Ahead

Provider trainings are planned with Carewell to integrate training materials.

Phase 2 Design

PTC is meeting to discuss changes and updates to automate many processes, including those being done by local offices

News Posts/Login

Consumers, providers, or staff will login and see new updates and resources.

Mask Mandates/Meeting in Person

Masks are not required in state offices, but people are welcome to wear them.

Providers are still required to wear masks around consumer-employers.

Hybrid Meeting
