Kristen Eisenman and David Scott Vining shared highlights from the monthly report.

- **Ontario Trip**

David Scott Vining reminded the committee that Cheryl Miller, Roberta Lilly, Yetu Dumbia, and Patrick Van Orden from OHCC were out in Ontario, OR for a week of outreach to providers in the region. Focus was on outreach to the Arabic, Somali, and Spanish speaking providers. Roberta will be providing a fuller conversation at the July committee meeting.

- **PDC Update - ICC**

David Scott Vining informed the training committee that the OHCC Commissioners voted in approval of Introduction to Cultural Competency (ICC) being included as an elective course for the Professional Development Certification. Providers who complete the course from June 15, 2019 forward may count the course towards the required 5 hours of elective courses.

Rachel Hansen voiced concern over the instructors being properly certified for the delivery of the training. David responded that the course is considered a general, introductory course with the basic information that a profession training instructor would be fully capable of delivering by sticking to the developed material.

- **Course Update – LGBTQ**

David Scott Vining informed the committee about the progress of reviewing materials for the new LGBTQ course underdevelopment. In the meantime, due to requests from providers around the state, the current LGBTQ course, with modifications made in January 2019, will once again be offered as a class.

Rachel Hansen asked if the Lavender Caucus of SEIU were aware of the course being offered; which they were as they have participated in the workgroups.

- **Course Update - DBN**

Kristen Eisenman gave a brief overview of some changes to the course Diabetes By the Numbers (DBN) which included a new display board with general information about diabetes and models depicting wounds that might develop when poorly managed.
