Meeting Minutes/Summary:

April minutes were reviewed and approved.

Presentation from OSU Center for Health Innovation: Enhanced Certification

Ann Custer, Manager of Workforce Development and Corporate Relations, and Marissa Song Mayeda, Graduate Assistant, presented the remodel for OHCC's Enhanced Certification. The remodel was demonstrated through OSU's learning management system (LMS) PACE. The certification will be a full 24 hours of blended model training – 12 hours online, 12 hours in-person. The training will utilize the use of pre- and post-assessments to gauge learning outcomes, videos, interactions, quality materials, discussions, and demonstration of skills. The certification has an anticipated roll-out soon. A discussion regarding accessibility for those HCWs and PSWs with limited access to computers will be forthcoming.

Training Report:

Roberta Lilly reviewed the Training Report numbers – recognizing that they reflected the online training that has been occurring since physical distancing has been implemented.

Driver's Safety Course:

Roberta Lilly demonstrated some of the PowerPoint from the Driver's Safety course. 51 students attended the full 2.5 hours of training. The course is interactive and applies as safety-type requirements for the PDC.

New Worker Orientations:

Jenny Cokeley provided an update on the status of the orientation for new workers offered through Carewell. HCWs and PSWs Orientations are being offered as online training. Launching this week.
