

OREGON SAVES FAQs

I received an email from OregonSaves; what do I need to do?

Oregon Saves is a retirement program that was included as a benefit for Personal Support Workers in the Collective Bargaining Agreement. If you do not wish to contribute to retirement, you must Opt Out.

- **How do I Opt Out of OregonSaves?**

You can go to the website: www.Oregonsaves.com to Opt Out or call 1-844-661-6777 and tell them that you do not wish to have an OregonSaves retirement savings account.

- **I want to contribute to my OregonSaves retirement account. How do I set up my account in Oregon Saves?**

Go to saver.oregonsaves.com and click “Set up your account.” You will need to set up a username and password.

- **Can I set up my OregonSaves account or opt out without using the website?**

Yes: call 1-844-661-6777

The state cannot opt out for you. You must contact Oregon Saves directly.

How long do I have to Opt out?

You can opt-out up to 30 days after receiving your invitation from Oregon Saves. After 30 days, you can stop your retirement contributions at any time by calling 1-844-661-6777.

What if I didn't receive an invitation from Oregon Saves?

Go to saver.oregonsaves.com to set up your account directly.

Why is PPL reducing my pay?

Effective the pay period of 10/1/2020 – 10/15/2020, the Oregon Saves retirement program goes into effect. If you have not “opted out” there will be a 5% reduction in your payroll, post tax, that goes into your retirement account. It is still your money and you have access to it through OregonSaves.

PPL cannot reimburse these funds; you must contact Oregon Saves at 844-661-6777.

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When will my first contribution be made?

Your first contribution will be deducted from the payroll period following the 30-day OregonSaves opt-out period.
