Snake River Correctional Institution inmate Michael Kuhnhausen Sr. dies of natural causes

Inmate Michael Kuhnhausen Sr., 65, died of natural causes at approximately 4:20 p.m. on Friday, June 13, in the Snake River Correctional Institution infirmary. Next of kin has been notified.

Kuhnhausen entered Department of Corrections custody on September 10, 2007, on one count of soliciting aggravated murder out of Multnomah County. He was scheduled to be released September 14, 2014.

Located in Ontario, SRCI is Oregon's largest prison, housing approximately 2,800 adults in custody. It provides a range of correctional services and programs, including education, cognitive programming, work-based education, parenting classes, and other work opportunities. SRCI opened in 1991.
