Two Rivers Correctional Institution (TRCI), in conjunction with Java Junkies in Umatilla, are looking for bike donations to support the Cycles of Hope program. Adults in custody at TRCI's minimum facility learn valuable skills along with an opportunity to give back to the community. TRCI is a multi-custody prison in Umatilla that houses approximately 1,800 male inmates. TRCI participates in prison industries with Oregon Corrections Enterprises including institution and industrial laundry, mattress manufacturing, and sewing. Other institution work programs include reparation and cleaning of irrigation ditches, maintenance of local baseball fields, and work with local cities and the Hermiston School District. The facility provides a range of correctional programs and services including education, religious services, and behavioral health services. TRCI opened in 2000.
