COFFEE CREEK CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION

Coffee Creek Correctional Facility (CCCF) is a multi-custody prison accommodating all of Oregon's female adults in custody (AICs) from intake to release. It is also home to the state's intake center, providing evaluation of all male AICs committed to state custody by the courts. CCCF opened its minimum-security facility in October 2001 and its medium-security facility in April 2002.
