The OMCC put on the annual cookie fundraiser in August of 2025 that included 2 different options, where you could order 1, or 2 dozen sugar or chocolate chip cookies. The recrea-


tional team was able to hand out the cookies to 468 AIC's purchased inside the medium and minimum facility starting in September. The OMCC executive board was able to deliver the cookies to those in SRCM. This fundraiser which was done at Snake River was able to produce a donation of \$2,500 to the 4 Rivers Community School. We'd like to give a special and appreciated thanks to the AIC who donated and additional \$1,000 to the cause. Half of the donated funds will be specifically used for a food drive within the



school, and the other half is going to be used as seed money to fund the opening of a new school building. FRC School is also honoring the club by making them a part of their "river of support" wall, which recognizes community donors.

In accordance with OAR 291-131-0025(12)(c), if mailroom employees determine a publication or specific issue of that publication contains material that is prohibited under these or other department administrative rules, the mail violation and publication violation notice (CD 618a) and prohibited material shall be reviewed by a designated Central Administration official, who will affirm, reverse, or otherwise modify the original rejection decision in writing. For instance, the last issue of Strip LV #223 was rejected due to content. The decision to reject this publication was made by Central Administration in Salem, not at SRCI. At any time, publications that were previously approved, can be re-reviewed and rejected by Central Administration in Salem.

Seasonal Ice Melt Training for Grounds Crews Winter is upon us and soon staff and AIC grounds crews will be spreading Ice Melt to counteract the effects of icy conditions and snow. In the next few months please take note of the Ice Melt training to more effectively help with this ongoing winter project. TRAINING #1 - Care of Spreader and Ice Melt Product - *NOTE* Spreaders range in price from \$150 to \$500* To avoid breaking spreader, please make sure ice melt is stored in a dry area and bag is closed to avoid clumping. Put on rubber gloves and break-up clumps before use in spreader so spreader blades do not break. To avoid using too much ice melt. Place spreader on the setting that sends out the least amount of ice melt. One cup of ice melt equals one driveway or ten (10) sidewalk squares. More is NOT best! More training to come. Stay tuned!
